Reconstruction Acts
Laws that divided the South into five districts
Each district was controlled by a military
<ul> <li>Each district would remain under military control until southern states rejoined the Union</li> </ul>
States had to write a new and allow African American men to
Johnson impeachment
Impeachment - the process used by a legislative body to bring of wrongdoing against public official
<ul> <li>Congress passed a law preventing the President from removing officials without Senate approval</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Johnson quickly violated/broke the law by firing Sec. of War</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The House of Representatives impeached Johnson, according to the Constitution, the Senate holds the trial</li> </ul>
majority is required to remove from office
Johnson survived by a single vote
*The trial weakened the power of the president
Election of 1868
Johnson did not run for another
<ul> <li>Republican (party of Lincoln), Ulysses S. Grant appealed to many northerners, war hero, ran und the slogan "Let Us Have Peace"</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Wins the presidency with numerous blacks voting in the South despite white southerners using     to try and keep them away.</li> </ul>
Civil War Amendments
Many were worried that southern states might try to keep black voters from the polls
Amendment: Gave African American men the right to vote
